



## 2005 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 2

January 11, 2005 – Introduced by Representative ZIEGELBAUER, cosponsored by Senator LEIBHAM. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** the life and military service of United States Army Staff Sergeant  
2             Charles Anthony Kiser.

3             Whereas, SSG Kiser was born on October 24, 1966, in Cincinnati, Ohio, to  
4     Charles and Glenda Kiser, and died on June 24, 2004, near Mosul, Iraq, while serving  
5     in Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

6             Whereas, SSG Kiser attended St. Bernadette Elementary School, graduated  
7     from McNicholas High School in Cincinnati in 1985, and attended the University of  
8     Cincinnati for one year before enlisting in the U.S. Navy, where he served for 7 years  
9     on active duty, and then served for 7 years in the Navy reserve at NMCB-25 in Green  
10    Bay, Wisconsin, before joining in 2001 the U.S. Army's 330th Military Police  
11    Detachment based at the FALE U.S. Army Reserve Center in Sheboygan, Wisconsin;

13            Whereas, SSG Kiser moved with his family to Cleveland, Wisconsin, in 1994,  
14    was a supervisor at GKN Sinter Metals in Manitowoc, Wisconsin, until being called  
15    to active duty in December 2003; and
