



2005 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 23

March 28, 2005 – Introduced by Representative CULLEN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Thomas M. Schaus.

2 Whereas, Thomas M. Schaus was born on June 7, 1937, in Milwaukee,
3 Wisconsin, and died on May 11, 2004; and

4 Whereas, he earned a BS degree from Marquette University in 1959 and an
5 LLB degree from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1962; and

6 Whereas, Mr. Schaus served in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserves; and

7 Whereas, he practiced law in Milwaukee from 1962 to 2002; and

8 Whereas, Mr. Schaus was elected to the Wisconsin assembly in 1964, serving
9 in the 1965 session; and

10 Whereas, during his tenure in the legislature, Mr. Schaus was a member of the
11 Committee on Judiciary, the Committee on Municipalities, and the Legislative
12 Council Judiciary Committee; now, therefore, be it

13 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the
14 Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service that Thomas M. Schaus

1 contributed to this state and his community, express their sorrow at his death, and
2 extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further

3 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
4 resolution to Mr. Schaus's mother, Alice Schaus, and sister, Yvonne Schilling.
