



2005 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 16

March 15, 2005 - Introduced by Senators HANSEN and COWLES, cosponsored by Representatives KRAWCZYK, NELSON and VAN ROY. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** honoring and applauding the 2004-2005 University of
2 Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team and Head Coach Kevin
3 Borseth on another very successful regular season and wishing them the best
4 of luck in the NCAA tournament.

5 Whereas, the UW-Green Bay women's basketball team won its 4th consecutive
6 Horizon League women's basketball championship March 7, 2005, as the Phoenix
7 defeated Wright State at the Nutter Center, 58-48; and

8 Whereas, Tiffany Mor, a senior forward, was named the 2005 Horizon League
9 Player of the Year and led the Horizon League in scoring (16.2), field goal percentage
10 (61.6), and blocked shots (72), was named to the 2004-05 ESPN the Magazine
11 Academic All-America Second Team, and is one of 10 semifinalists for the 3rd annual
12 Creamland Dairies Collegiate Basketball Award of Excellence; and

13 Whereas, UW-Green Bay senior guard Abby Scharlow earned a place on the
14 All-Horizon League First Team for the 2nd consecutive season, sophomore forward
15 Nicole Soulis made the All-Horizon League Second Team for the 2nd year in a row,

1 senior guard Mary Kulenkamp was a repeat selection to the All-Horizon League
2 Defensive Team, and freshman guard Kayla Groh represented the Phoenix on the
3 All-Horizon League Newcomer Team; and

4 Whereas, Coach Kevin Borseth received his 6th Horizon League Coach of the
5 Year honor in 7 seasons by guiding the Phoenix to a 7th straight Horizon League
6 regular-season title, and Borseth is the all-time leader in Horizon League history
7 in league wins (95), winning percentage (89.6), and league tournament victories (17);

9 Whereas, the Phoenix is making its 4th consecutive trip to the NCAA
10 tournament and earned the No. 10 seed in the Philadelphia Region of the 2005 NCAA
11 tournament and will face the No. 7 seed University of Maryland on Sunday, March
12 20, 2005, in College Park, Maryland; now, therefore, be it

13 ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*** the legislature of
14 the state of Wisconsin honors and applauds the 2004–2005 University of
15 Wisconsin–Green Bay women’s basketball team and Head Coach Kevin Borseth on
16 another very successful regular season and wishes them the best of luck in the NCAA
17 tournament; and, be it further

19 resolution to Head Coach Kevin Borseth, his staff, each member of the team, and
20 Athletic Director Ken Bothof.
