2             Whereas, the 2005-06 University of Wisconsin men's cross country team  
3     claimed the 2005 NCAA Division I Men's Cross Country National Championship on  
4     Monday, November 21, 2005; and

5             Whereas, the UW men's cross country team finished its remarkable season as  
6     the top-ranked team in the country, making the team's 34th consecutive NCAA  
7     appearance, and bringing home the 4th NCAA Championship to continue the UW  
8     men's cross country program's long tradition of success and excellence; and

9             Whereas, the UW men's cross country team was recognized with a number of  
10    team and individual achievements, including 6 all-Americans, Big Ten Freshman  
11    of the Year (Matt Withrow), and U.S. Track Coaches Association National Athlete of  
12    the Year (Simon Bairu); and

13            Whereas, UW Head Coach Jerry Schumacher was named Coach of the Year by  
14    the U.S. Track Coaches Association in recognition of his team's tremendous
