

Brief History

Park School is located on the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire campus. It was originally a campus-run school and is currently part of the Eau Claire Area School District.

Parking near Park School is very difficult. The street parking is usually full for many blocks from the university. The parking lots require permits and are also usually full. There is one visitor's lot near Park School. Sometimes there is space in this lot for volunteers but the university was not able to guarantee any spots for Park School and as a result there are times that the nearest parking is on the other side of the river.

Reason for the Request

Research continues to identify parental involvement in schooling as an important contributing factor to successful learning. In addition, volunteers can provide a valuable service to students in the classroom. Some parents and other volunteers who would be willing to assist at school find it difficult to do so due to lack of parking.

University personnel were approached to try to get a few guaranteed parking spaces for Park parents and volunteers. The University was unable to provide the parking space but had no opposition to exploring the possibility of using Park Avenue. The city ordinances were then examined to see if permit parking could be allowed on Park Avenue directly in front of Park School. At that time it was noted that city ordinances could not permit such parking without a change in the state law.

Benefits to Park School

Permit parking in front of Park School would enable school staff to invite and welcome more parental participation in the school program and to utilize more volunteers to support learning. The benefits of this are immeasurable!
