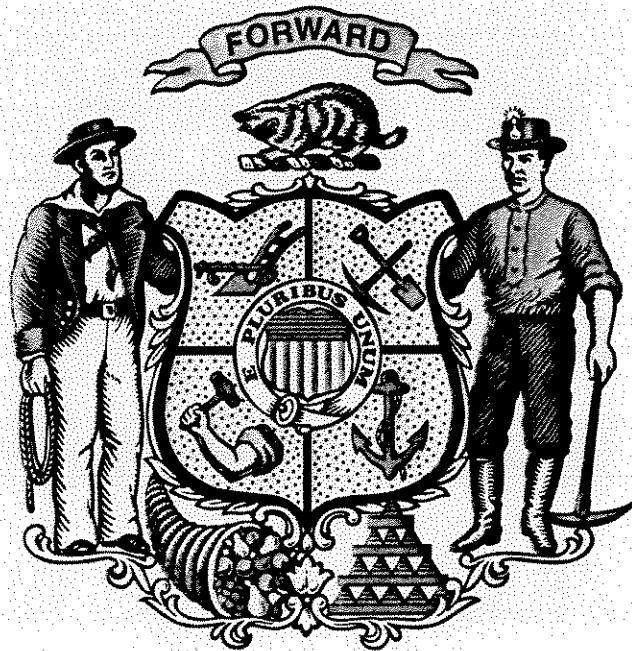
Dear Senator Olsen:

Governor Doyle recently forwarded to the Senate his nomination of Diane Everson to serve on the Educational Communications Board. This appointment is invalid on several counts: (1) She would be filling the seat for a member with an interest in public television who resides within the coverage area of a television channel licensed to the Educational Communications Board (s. 15.57(6m)). Everson's Edgerton residence is not in the coverage area of an ECB station; (2) The governor's letter of appointment indicates that Everson would serve at the pleasure of the Governor. ECB Board members do not serve at the pleasure of the Governor. They are either ex officio or they serve 4-year terms.

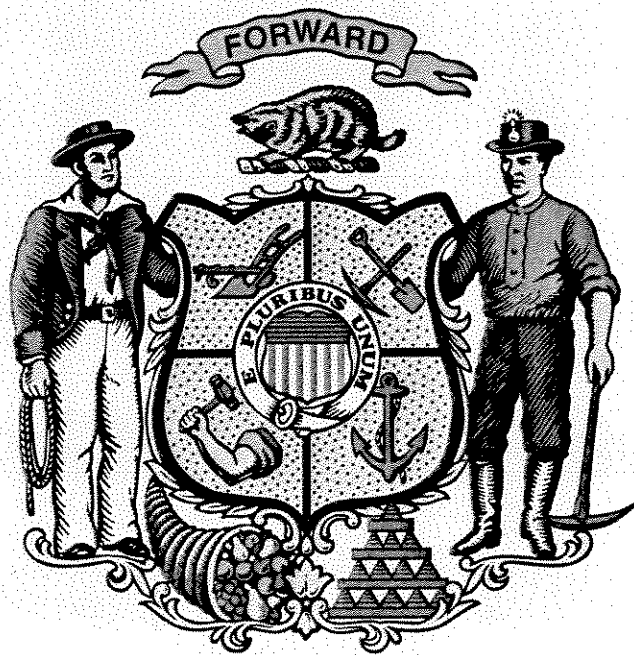

Hi Cory. I think I have cleared everything up.

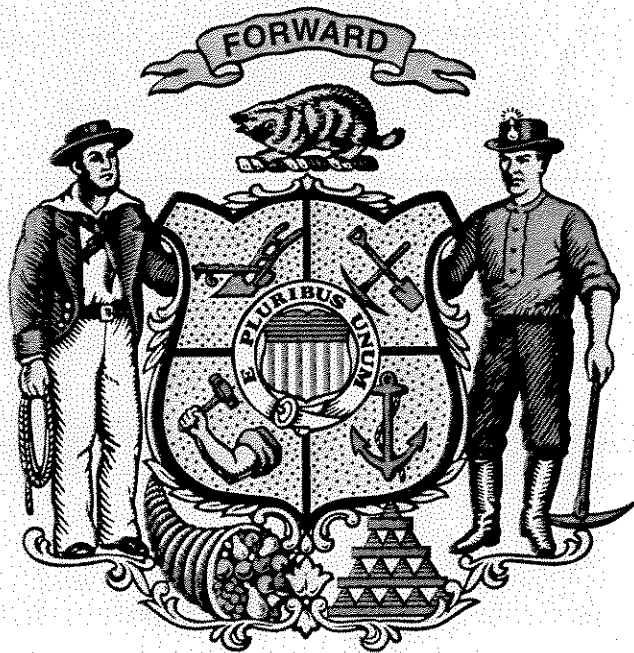
First, both Eileen and Diane will be at the hearing at 10am

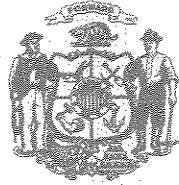
Second, I have redone the paperwork and hand delivered it to Jeff Renk at the Senate Chief Clerk's office and he said he would fast track that to you.

I swapped Diane and Eileen's positions on the board and their expirations, therefore, have changed. I called the legal counsel at the Ethics board and talked to our in-house legal counsel about the "pleasure of the Governor term" for the TV coverage area rep. They looked into it and said since statutes don't specify the term, we should follow whatever the previous appointee was appointed as. David Hutchison, the previous appointee, was appointed 1/12/01 by Gov. Thompson to expire at the pleasure of the Governor. 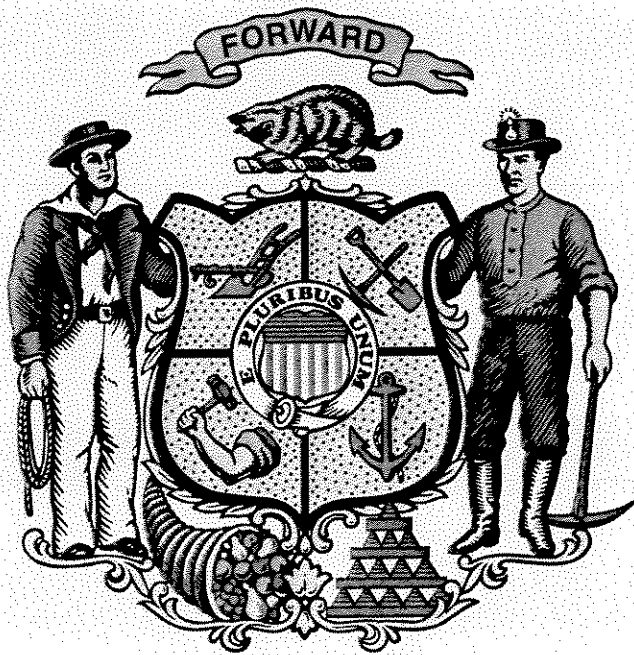
