Transportation of Public School Pupils who live outside the school district in which they
are enrolled
Senate Committee on Education
October 18, 2005

- Thank you to committee
- Currently school districts provide transportation for pupils who live 2 or more miles away from the nearest school they're entitled to attend.
- This legislation will do two things:
 1. It will require a school district to provide transportation only within school district boundaries; and,
 2. It will, upon the request of a parent, require the school district to transport a child to and from a location inside the district (such as an existing bus stop) when the student is living outside the district due to a joint custody agreement.
