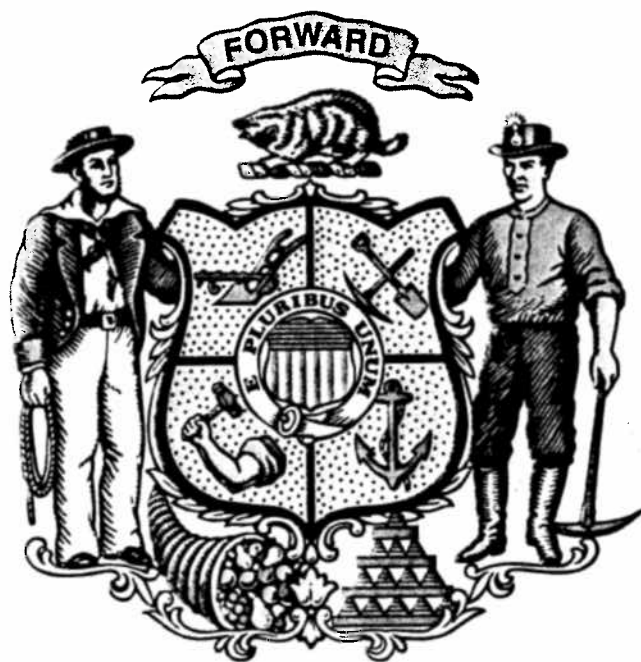

SUBJECT: Budget for the Lieutenant Governor's Office

You requested information regarding the budget for the Lieutenant Governor's Office. That information is provided below.

The Lieutenant Governor's Office is located in the first floor East of the State Capitol. For fiscal year 2004-05, the Office has a total budget of \$347,200 GPR and is authorized a total of 3.0 staff positions. The budget of the Office consists of salary and fringe benefit costs for the Lieutenant Governor and staff and funding for supplies and services costs associated with operations of the Office. Offices in the Capitol are not assessed a rental charge. The breakdown of the 2004-05 budget is shown below.

Budget for Lieutenant Governor's Office

The 2005-07 budget request for the Office was for a total of \$393,900 GPR annually.

The salary for the Lieutenant Governor is set under the state compensation plan. The current salary of the Lieutenant Governor is \$69,579.
