



Dear State Representatives:

On behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, I would like to express concerns with Assembly Bill 63, which requires a voter to show either a driver's license, ID card issued by a uniform service, or a photo ID issued by a state Division of Motor Vehicles office. The Oneida Nation is comprised of approximately 15,000 Tribal Citizens, including 2,000 residents who reside in the Milwaukee area. Our general concern is this bill would disenfranchise many of our elders who do not have a Wisconsin drivers license or would find it difficult to obtain a photo ID issued by a state Division of Motor Vehicles office.

The Oneida Nation issues photo identification to all Tribal members as part of the process of maintaining the official rolls of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin. Individual Tribal identification cards contain the following information:

- a. Name
- b. Birth date
- c. Tribal Enrollment Number
- d. Physical Description
- e. Signature of Cardholder
- f. Signature of the Chairperson of the Tribe
- g. Signature of the Enrollment office staff person

The Oneida Nation is recognized by the federal government as a sovereign government. Tribal ID's are designed to be secure and are issued in a manner to prevent abuse and misuse. Currently, we are in the process of further refining our Tribal ID procedures by adopting the same "hard card" system used by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to produce driver's licenses. The Wisconsin DOT has indicated to us that when we adopt this new technology, they will honor Tribal ID's for purposes of obtaining a Wisconsin Identification Card.

We would strongly encourage you to support amendment language in the bill which would allow the use of Tribal Identification Cards for voting purposes.
