

Currently, the following bills which I have authored (listed in order of my opinion of value to the citizens of Wisconsin) have been referred to the Senate Natural Resources & Transportation Committee:

Assembly Bill 534 (DOT Surplus Land Sales)
Assembly Bill 426 (Specialized Transportation Assistance Program)
Assembly Bill 340 (Agricultural Vehicle Lighting)
Assembly Bill 97 (Empty Weight Display on Commercial Motor Vehicles)
Assembly Bill 95 (Low Speed Electric Bicycles)

I would like to respectfully request that Assembly Bills 534, 426, 95, and 97 be scheduled for a public hearing at your earliest convenience.

Assembly Bill 340 received a public hearing before your committee on October 26, 2005, but has yet to be scheduled for executive committee action. Your consideration of scheduling this bill for a vote would also be sincerely appreciated.
