Dear Senator Kedzie and Representative Gunderson:

The Department of Commerce is submitting a germane modification to Clearinghouse Rule Number 05–081, relating to petroleum products. The Department is submitting this modification pursuant to section 227.19 (4) (b) 3. of the Statutes.

This modification addresses certification of automotive fuel ratings. Under this modification, delivery of automotive fuel to a retail outlet must include a certification of the automotive fuel rating, either by letter or on the delivery ticket or other paper, as required by 16 CFR 306.10 (g). Incorporating this federal requirement into chapter Comm 48 would complement the currently incorporated federal requirement in section Comm 48.10 (1) (a), for providing this automotive fuel rating on each retail fuel dispenser.

The modification is attached for your reference.

In the attached modification, section Comm 48.580 (3) (a) is intended to replace section Comm 48.580 (3) (a) within SECTION 16 of the previously submitted rules in final draft form.

Germane Modification to Clearinghouse Rule 05-081

[Within SECTION 16.] Comm 48.580 (3) (a) General. Any person receiving, unloading, using, offering for sale or selling any petroleum product shall identify the product as to name or grade. A person may not deliberately deliver, unload or drop any dissimilar fuels, dissimilar octane or dissimilar grade of petroleum products into tank storage that would allow fraudulent fuel sales. Delivery of automotive fuel to a retail outlet shall include a certification of the automotive fuel rating, either by letter or on the delivery ticket or other paper, as required by 16 CFR 306.10 (g).
