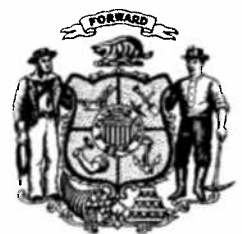



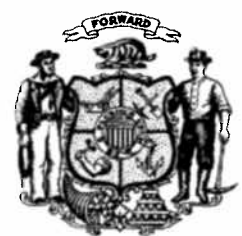

(1) No pair may be recognized unless one or both of the parties thereto are absent with leave. (2) If one party to a pair is present and votes, the pair is invalidated. (3) Pairs are applicable to the main questions on a proposal and do not apply to amendments or procedure motions unless the pair so specifies. (4) A pair shall not be counted as part of the official result of a vote but shall be recorded.
