



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO 2007 SENATE BILL 20**

September 13, 2007 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “fighters” insert “, rescue squad members, emergency
3 medical technicians,”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 1: delete that line and substitute:

5 “**SECTION 1g.** 341.14 (6r) (g) of the statutes is renumbered 341.14 (6r) (g) 1. and
6 amended to read:”.

7 **3.** Page 2, line 2: after “(g)” insert “1.”.

8 **4.** Page 2, line 2: before “sub.” insert “subd. 2. and”.

9 **5.** Page 2, line 7: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 1m.** 341.14 (6r) (g) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

11 341.14 (**6r**) (g) 2. If an individual in possession of special plates under par. (f)
12 33., 34., or 48. or of personalized plates under s. 341.145 (1) (c) of the same color and
13 design as special plates under par. (f) 33., 34., or 48. suffers an injury in the course

1 of his or her job duties as a fire fighter, rescue squad member, or emergency medical
2 technician and the injury prevents the individual from subsequently performing
3 such job duties, the individual may retain these special plates.”.

4 **6.** Page 2, line 21: after that line insert:

5 **“SECTION 2m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

6 (1) Any individual who was in possession, on September 1, 2007, of special
7 plates described in section 341.14 (6r) (g) 2. of the statutes, as created by this act, who
8 suffered an injury in the course of his or her job duties as a fire fighter, rescue squad
9 member, or emergency medical technician that prevents the individual from
10 subsequently performing such job duties, and who was required to surrender these
11 special plates between September 1, 2007, and the effective date of this subsection
12 or whose special plates expired during this time period may apply to the department
13 of transportation for reissuance of these special plates. Upon application, the
14 department of transportation shall reissue these special plates at no additional fee.”.
