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

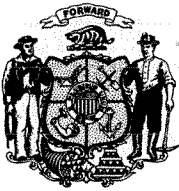

This bill provides that no member of the assembly or senate may accumulate unused sick leave from year to year in his or her sick leave account for work performed as a member of the legislature in any legislative session beginning on or after January 5, 2009. The bill, however, does permit senators who are currently serving a term of office that begins on or after January 3, 2007, but before January 5, 2009, to continue to accumulate unused sick leave for work performed as a member of the legislature before the commencement of the 2011-2012 legislative session. *check*
