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

1 AN ACT to amend 346.02 (1) of the statutes; relating to: the applicability of rules  
2 of the road to private roads located in mobile home parks. ✓

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Under current law, rules of the road apply upon highways, with certain exceptions. Current law defines "highway" to include all public ways and thoroughfares and bridges on the same. "Highway" includes roads or driveways in parks and in state forests that are open to the public and roads or driveways that are on the grounds of public schools and under the jurisdiction of the county. However, a private road or driveway is not considered a highway. ✓

This bill applies all of the rules of the road to private roads that are located within mobile home parks. ✓

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

3 SECTION 1. 346.02 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4 346.02 (1) APPLIES PRIMARILY UPON HIGHWAYS. This chapter applies exclusively  
5 upon highways and <sup>upon</sup> private roads that are located within mobile home parks, as  
6 defined in s. 66.0435 (1) (e), except as otherwise expressly provided in this chapter.

The attached draft applies the rules of the road to mobile home parks, which are defined under s. 66.0435 (1) (e) as "any plot or plots of ground upon which 2 or more units, occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes are located, regardless of whether a charge is made for the accommodation." As drafted, s. 346.02 (1) would apply to a broader variety of properties than a typical mobile home park, including property where one family member living in a mobile home permitted a second family member to set their own mobile home on the property. Do you wish to have this bill apply to all properties that fit that definition of mobile home park or limit its application only to mobile home parks of a particular minimum size? \*
