#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Current law defines "highway" to include all public ways, thoroughfares and bridges. Highway also includes roads or driveways in parks and in state forests that are open to the public and roads or driveways that are on the grounds of public schools and under the jurisdiction of the county. However, a private road or driveway is not considered a highway.

AB 25 amends s.346.02 of the statutes to apply the rules of the road to private roads that are located within mobile home parks.

Because the total number of moving and non-moving traffic violations (identified in s.346.02) that occur on private roads located in mobile home parks cannot be estimated, the associated fiscal costs and projected revenue are indeterminable.

Note that 1995 Act 127 amended and expanded the Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) laws to include offenses taking place on rental housing property of 4 or more units whether such premises are publicly or privately owned and whether or not a fee is charged for their use. Therefore, OWI laws (included in s.346.02) currently apply to mobile home parks with 4 or more units that are not owner-occupied.
