#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

#### Bill Summary:

This bill makes the wearing of a personal flotation device (PFD) mandatory for children age 12 and under, when in a boat that is under way and is less then 26 feet in length. The bill provides an exemption from this requirement for those persons in a cabin space or below deck. The PFD must be a type I, II, III or V as specified under 33 CFR part 175, subpart B. The passing of this law would make Wisconsin consistent with current federal law pertaining to PFD wear for children of this age.

#### Fiscal Estimate:

There will be no state or local fiscal impact. The Department will need to inform the public of this bill, if passed. The Department currently produces and distributes public service announcements (PSA) throughout the state, and this would be a topic of a PSA. Any law enforcement workload issues will be addressed through normal boat patrol activities.
