1	AN ACT <i>to repeal</i> 16.46 (5g); <i>to amend</i> 16.43; and <i>to create</i> 16.423 (5) of the
2	statutes; relating to: base budget review reports.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 16.423 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
4	16.423 (5) Notwithstanding sub. (4), a state agency may use any format for its
5	report. If a state agency uses a format for a report that is different from the format
6	that the state agency used for one or more previous reports, the state agency shall
7	reissue all previous reports in the new format.
8	SECTION 2. 16.43 of the statutes is amended to read:
9	16.43 Budget compiled. The secretary shall compile and submit to the
10	governor or the governor–elect and to each person elected to serve in the legislature
11	during the next biennium, not later than November 20 of each even-numbered year,

1 a compilation giving all of the data required by s. 16.46 to be included in the state 2 budget report, except the recommendations of the governor and the explanation 3 thereof. The secretary shall not include in the compilation any provision for the 4 development or implementation of an information technology development project 5 for an executive branch agency that is not consistent with the strategic plan of the 6 agency, as approved under s. 16.976. The secretary may distribute the budget 7 compilation in printed or optical disk format. As part of the budget compilation, the 8 secretary shall also submit the base budget review reports under s. 16.423 for the 9 current fiscal biennium and the most recent statements submitted under s. 16.42 (1) 10 (b) for each state agency. 11 **SECTION 3.** 16.46 (5g) of the statutes is repealed.
