1. Page 2, line 16: delete the material beginning with "An" and ending with "limits." on page 2 line 18.

Page 2, line 19: delete the material beginning with that line and ending on page 3, line 21 and substitute:

"Section 4c. 23.33 (5) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 23.33 (5) (a) 1. and amended to read:

23.33 (5) (a) 1. No person under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle unless he or she is operating the all-terrain vehicle for an agricultural purpose and he or she is under the supervision of a person over 18 years of age or unless he or she is operating a small all-terrain vehicle on an all-terrain vehicle trail designated by the department and he or she is accompanied by his or her parent. No

person who is under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle which is an implement of husbandry on a roadway under any circumstances. No person who is under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle on a roadway under the authorization provided under sub. (4) (d) 6. under any circumstances. No person who is under 12 years of age may rent or lease an all-terrain vehicle. For purposes of this paragraph subdivision, supervision does not require that the person under 12 years of age be subject to continuous direction or control by the person over 18 years of age.

23.33 (5) (b) 1. No person who is at least 12 years of age and who is born on or after January 1, 1988, may operate an all-terrain vehicle unless he or she holds a valid safety certificate issued by this state or another state or by a province of Canada.

An instructor conducting the program of instruction under this paragraph shall collect the fee from each person who receives instruction. The department may determine the portion of this fee, which may not exceed 50%, that the instructor may retain to defray expenses incurred by the instructor in conducting the program. The instructor shall remit the remainder of the fee or, if nothing is retained, the entire fee to the department. Persons enrolled in a safety certification program approved by the department may operate an all-terrain vehicle in an area designated by the instructor.".
