ASSEMBLY BILL 61
TO 2007 SENATE BILL 25

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: after "committees" insert "and providing a penalty".

3 **#2.** Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:

4 "SECTION 1m. 11.25 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 11.25 (2) (b) Notwithstanding par. (a), a registrant may accept contributions
6 and make disbursements from a campaign depository account for the purpose of
7 making expenditures in connection with a campaign for national office; for payment
8 of civil penalties incurred by the registrant under for a violation of any provision of
9 this chapter except s. 11.24 (4) but not under for a violation of any other chapter; for
10 the purpose of making a donation to a charitable organization or the common school
11 fund; or for payment of the expenses of nonpartisan campaigns to increase voter
12 registration or participation. Notwithstanding par. (a), a personal campaign
13 committee or support committee may accept contributions and make disbursements

1 from a campaign depository account for payment of inaugural expenses of an
2 individual who is elected to state or local office. If such expenses are paid from
3 contributions made to the campaign depository account, they are reportable under
4 s. 11.06 (1) as disbursements. Otherwise, such expenses are not reportable under s.
5 11.06 (1). If contributions from the campaign depository account are used for such
6 expenses, they are subject to s. 11.26.”
