Eligibility for tuition fee remission for family members of certain veterans							

#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, a spouse, child, or unremarried surviving spouse of certain veterans is eligible for a full remission of tuition at the University of Wisconsin System and at technical colleges. For the spouse, unremarried surviving spouse, or child to be eligible, the veteran must have entered service while a resident of this state and either died while on duty or incurred a service—connected disability that is rated as 30 percent or more. This bill adds fee remission eligibility to the spouse or child of a veteran if the veteran is a resident of this state and was a resident of this state for at least 15 continuous years before the student registers.

In general, the Department of Veterans Affairs estimates that approximately one third of recipients of Wisconsin veterans benefits (not specifically the Wisconsin GI Bill benefits) qualify for benefits on the basis of establishing residency after their period of service.

Therefore, to estimate the additional cost of this legislation, the UW System anticipates that an additional one third of the total number of spouses and children may become eligible for benefits and will claim eligibility for the tuition remissions. In the Fall of 2006 (the last semester for which we have tallies), 476 spouses and children claimed tuition remissions. If an additional one third were eligible, this would amount to approximately 157 additional remissions per semester. At approximately \$1673 per student, this would total \$293,000 per semester, or \$586,000 for an academic year. If one includes an additional 8% for summer school tuition, the annual total approximates \$632,000.

The Governor's budget includes funding for these remissions, above present levels.

#### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

If the number of Wisconsin veterans increases and as tuition increases, these costs will also grow.
