## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the sale or distribution of an elastic yo-yo, defined in the bill as any toy known as a "yo-yo waterball" or any other similar toy consisting of a rubber–like object that is attached to an elastic cord.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report concerning the proposed penalty and the costs or savings that are likely to result if the bill is enacted.

## *The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** 100.55 of the statutes is created to read:

**100.55 Sale and distribution of elastic yo-yos prohibited. (1)** In this

- 5 section, "elastic yo-yo" means any toy known as a "yo-yo waterball" or any similar
- 6 toy consisting of a rubber–like object that is attached to an elastic cord.
  - (2) No person may sell or distribute an elastic yo-yo to a person in this state.
