

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 205**

April 24, 2007 – Offered by Representatives MURSAU, KERKMAN, TAUCHEN, LOTHIAN
and MUSSER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 2: delete “The governor” and substitute “**(1)** Except as provided
3 under sub. (2), the governor”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 8: after that line insert:

5 “**(2)** The governor may concur with a determination of the U.S. secretary of the
6 interior, under 25 USC 2719 (b) (1) (A), that a gaming establishment proposed to be
7 located on lands acquired by the U.S. secretary of the interior in trust for the benefit
8 of an Indian tribe after October 17, 1988, would be in the best interest of the Indian
9 tribe and its members and would not be detrimental to the surrounding community
10 without the legislature first concurring in the determination by joint resolution if,
11 before the effective date of this subsection ... [revisor inserts date], all of the
12 following conditions are satisfied:
