5	2. Page 2, line 7: delete <u>"under all of the following circumstances</u> is guilty" and
6	substitute " is guilty ".
7	3. Page 2, line 8: delete "of a Class I felony. <u>:</u> " and substitute " of a Class I felony.
8	under all of the following circumstances:".
9	4. Page 2, line 18: after that line insert:
10	"SECTION 4m. 940.20 (5) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
11	940.20 (5) (c) 1. A person who intentionally causes bodily harm in violation of
12	par. (b) is guilty of a Class I felony.

2. A person who threatens to cause bodily harm in violation of par. (b) is guilty
of a Class A misdemeanor.".
