AB 294 (Electrical Licensing) Amendment Drafting Request

Mary,

I have yet another request for an amendment to our electrical licensing bill.

During an executive session earlier this week, committee members expressed a desire to see the bill amended to allow a duplex owner - who lives in one of the units - to be exempt from the licensing requirement. In other words, if the duplex owner lives in one unit and rents out the other, the owner could do any electrical work (install, maintain and repair) in the entire duplex regardless of which unit he or she occupies. My boss does want to require that the owner live in one of the units to be eligible for the exemption, and wants to limit the exemption to single and two family residences. The exemption should not be applicable to buildings with 3 or more units.

The Department of Commerce recommended the following approach to achieving this goal (new text underlined):

(Pg. 10, lines 1-3)

(a) A residential property owner who installs, repairs, or maintains electrical wiring on premises that the property owner owns and occupies as a <u>single family residence or two family</u> residence unless a license or registration issued by the department is required by local ordinance.

Based on my explanation, do you think this suggestion gets us to where my boss wants to be? If so, let's get it drafted up. Otherwise, let me know what you think would be a more appropriate approach.

Hi Erin!

Thank you for sharing the draft amendment and for asking for our input.

We think that the proposed (am) does make it very clear that an owner can install electrical wiring on premises of a 2-family residence if that owner resides in one of the units.

However, we think that (a) is still not as clear as it should be; it could still be read as allowing an owner to install electrical wiring in an eight-unit building, etc.

In light of the proposed (am), we recommend that (a) be modified by inserting the words "single family" before the word "residence" on page 10, line 2.

Without such a change in (a). Commerce would clarify it in the subsequent administrative rule.
