Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a pupil enrolled in a public school in the 11th or 12th grade may attend an institution of higher education for one or more courses under the youth options program. The school board of the district in which the pupil is enrolled is responsible for paying the cost of tuition, fees and books for the pupil under certain circumstances. This bill eliminates the mandatory nature of the youth options program and permits the school district to establish its own youth option program. However, if a school district establishes such a program, it must pay the costs of tuition, course fees, books and other necessary materials related to the courses taken by participating students. As a result, there is no additional fiscal impact on the University of Wisconsin System.
