

2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 399

June 14, 2007 – Introduced by Representative NELSON. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Ethics.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 100.26 (4m); and **to create** 100.55 of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** prohibiting charging grossly excessive wholesale prices for motor vehicle
3 fuel and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits charging for motor vehicle fuel a wholesale price that grossly exceeds the wholesale price at which motor vehicle fuel is sold by another or that grossly exceeds the average wholesale price at which motor vehicle fuel was sold in the 12-month period immediately preceding a sale of the motor vehicle fuel. Under the bill, the attorney general investigates violations of, and enforces, the provisions of the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 100.26 (4m) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 100.26 (4m) Any person who violates s. 100.18 (10r) or 100.55 is subject to a
6 civil forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor more than \$10,000 for each violation.
