- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 120.12 (22) of the statutes; **relating to:** payment of the costs
- 2 of advanced placement examinations taken by certain pupils.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law directs each school board to pay the costs of advanced placement examinations taken by pupils who are eligible for free or reduced-price lunches under the federal School Lunch Program. This bill provides that the school board may use federal, state, local, or private funds to pay these costs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 120.12 (22) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 120.12 (22) ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS. Pay <u>Using federal, state, local,</u>
- 5 or private funds, pay the costs of advanced placement examinations taken by pupils
- 6 enrolled in the school district who are eligible for free or reduced-price lunches in the
- 7 federal school lunch program under 42 USC 1758.
