## DRAFTER'S NOTE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU

March 13, 2007

This is a redraft of 2005 Assembly Bill 1086. This redraft incorporates Assembly Amendment 1 to AB–1086. As in last session's bill, this version contains a nonstatutory provision that establishes a deadline for the Department of Commerce to submit proposed rules to the legislative council staff. Under current law, the Department of Administration is authorized to require the Department of Commerce to prepare an economic impact report for its proposed rules. If the Department of Administration requires such a report, this could increase the time it would take the Department of Commerce to submit its proposed rules under this draft. Upon reviewing this draft, I have assumed that you did not want to delay the rule–making process. Consequently, I have revised the nonstatutory provision to specify that the Department of Administration may not require that the Department of Commerce prepare an economic impact report for the proposed rules. Please let me know if my assumption is not consistent with your intent.
