I could not find a bill that defined "hardship" in the context of a residency requirement. There have been bills that explicitly exempt a husband and wife who are employed by different governmental units, both of which have employee residency requirements. See, for example, 1999 AB-484. If you wish, I could incorporate that into the amendment or provide that "undue hardship" means significant difficulty or expense.
