Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Among other provisions, this bill would prohibit a municipality (a city, village, or town) or a county from imposing a fee on the owner or occupant requesting law enforcement, fire protection, or other emergency services from the county or municipality.

If municipalities or counties were prohibited from imosing such fees, it is not possible to identify the fiscal effect since no data is available regarding the number of municipalities or counties that are currently charging the fees.
