Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2007 AB 521 would prohibit local units of government from adopting ordinances regarding the construction of public buildings and places of employment (i.e., commercial buildings) that are stricter than the state standards promulgated by the Department of Commerce.

The Department estimates that this legislation will result in a decrease in local government resources needed for the development, implementation and administration of differing standards. This decrease will impact those local units of government that currently have stricter commercial building standards than the Department's standards. The amount of this impact is indeterminable.
