2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 535

October 16, 2007 – Introduced by Representatives MOLEPSKE, HRAYCHUCK, HAHN and BERCEAU, cosponsored by Senators Sullivan and Lassa. Referred to Committee on Corrections and Courts.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 814.68 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** increasing 2 supplementary examination fees for supplemental court commissioners.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, supplemental court commissioners receive a fee of \$15 for attending a supplementary examination under ch. 816 at which a judgment debtor may be ordered to answer a judgment creditor's inquiries regarding the judgment debtor's property. This bill increases that fee to \$50.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 814.68 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 814.68 (2) SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS. For attendance upon an examination
- 5 under ch. 816, a supplemental court commissioner shall collect a fee of \$15 \$50 to be
- 6 paid upon the issuance of the order under s. 816.03 (1). The fee shall be returned in
- 7 any case where it appears by affidavit filed that the order was not served upon the

judgment debtor. This fee is the only fee a supplemental court commissioner is
entitled to for proceedings under ch. 816.

3 SECTION 2. Effective date.

4 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after5 publication.
