

For attendance upon an examination under ch. 816, a supplemental court commissioner shall collect a fee of \$15 \$50 to be paid upon the issuance of the order under s. 816.03 (1). The fee shall be returned in any case where it appears by affidavit filed that the order was not served upon the

judgment debtor. This fee is the only fee a supplemental court commissioner is entitled to for proceedings under ch. 816.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect on first day of the 4th month beginning after publication.
