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

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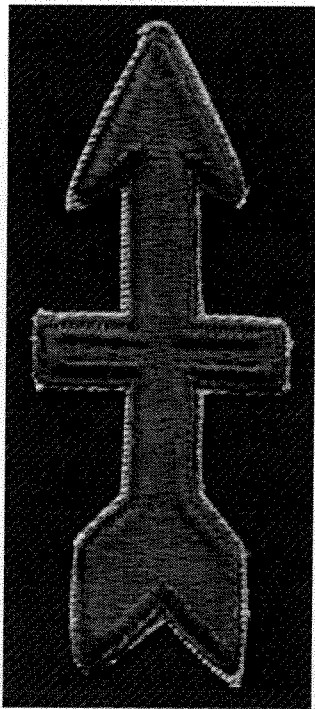

# The 32nd 'Red Arrow' Veteran Association



## Brief History of the "Red Arrow"

From the 32nd  
Division

to the 32nd Infantry  
Brigade

---

The Division's history has an honored past reaching back to its antecedents: the fighters of the Blackhawk War; the volunteers who marched off to defend the Union in the Civil War, including the famous 'Iron Brigade'; and the Governor's Guards who mobilized for the Spanish American War.

Almost all of the Michigan and Wisconsin National Guard units which would be combined to form the 32nd Division had served on the Mexican Border in 1916-17.

The 32nd Division was organized under War Dept. orders of **18 July 1917** of National Guard Units from both Wisconsin and Michigan. Units began leaving state camps in Wisconsin and Michigan bound for Camp MacArthur, near Waco, Texas, in early August 1917. The last units arrived at Camp MacArthur by late September 1917.

The Division served on the front line during World War I from **18 May 1918** until the end of the War on **11 November 1918**. It was the first American Division to pierce the famed Hindenburg Line, fought in 4 major offensives and earned the name "Les Terribles" from

the French.

The 32nd Division was the only American division to be bestowed with a *nom-de-guerre* by an Allied nation during the war.

The colors of all four Infantry Regiments, three Artillery Regiments and three Machine Gun Battalions were decorated with the French *Croix de Guerre With Palm*. These were the only National Guard units bestowed with the highest order of the *Croix de Guerre* during WWI.

The Division served with the Army of Occupation in Germany until **18 April 1919** and began its return to the U.S. on **1 May 1919**.

Returning home the Division was demobilized in **May 1919** and returned to National Guard status about a year later.

On **15 October 1940**, the 32nd Division, Wisconsin and Michigan National Guard, was again called to Active Duty.

In **August and September of 1941**, the 32nd Division participated in the 'Louisiana Maneuvers,' the greatest peacetime maneuver in the history of the United States Army.

On **22 April 1942**, the 32nd Division sailed from San Francisco, bound for the war in the South Pacific. They arrived in Port Adelaide, South Australia on **14 May 1942**.

On **15 September 1942** the first elements of the Division were flown from Australia to Port Moresby, New Guinea.

The 32nd Division was the first U.S. Division to fight an offensive action against the Japanese in the Southwest Pacific.

The Division fought in six major engagements in four Campaigns involving 654 days of combat, more than any other American Division.

Many firsts were accredited to the 32nd "Red Arrow" Division.

Eleven *Medals of Honor*, 157 *Distinguished Service Crosses*, 49 *Legion of Merit*, 845 *Silver Stars*, 1854 *Bronze Stars*, 98 *Air Medals*, 78 *Soldiers Medals* and 11,500 *Purple Hearts* were awarded its heroes.

On **2 September 1945** General Tomoyuki Yamashita, Highest Commander of the Imperial Japanese Army in the Philippines, surrendered to the 32nd Infantry Division on Luzon.

On **4 September 1945**, an advance detachment of the 32nd Division (1st Battalion, 127th Infantry) was flown to Kyushu (southern most of the four main Japanese islands) for occupation duty, only 5 days behind the earliest troop landings anywhere in Japan. The

remainder of the Division arrived in Japan by **14 October 1945**.

The 32nd Division was inactivated at Fukuoka, Japan on **28 February 1946**.

On **8 November 1946** the Division was again Federally recognized as the 32nd Infantry Division, Wisconsin National Guard.

On **15 October 1961**, the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Division, Wisconsin National Guard, was ordered to active duty because of the Berlin Crisis. The Division, after 13 weeks of intensive training, was pronounced STRAC and ready for deployment, if necessary.

In **August 1962**, the 32nd Division returned home to assume its peacetime role.

The 32nd Division was reorganized on **27 December 1967** and on that date ceased to exist as a full Division. However, the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade (Separate), Wisconsin National Guard, was created to continue the lineage and heritage of the famous 32nd "Red Arrow" Division.

In **April 1971** the Brigade was converted to a mechanized brigade and became the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade (Separate) (Mechanized), Wisconsin National Guard.

In **January 1986** the 32nd Brigade participated in REFORGER '86. The entire Brigade deployed from Wisconsin, with all of its equipment, to Germany.

In **October 1996** the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade (Mechanized), Wisconsin National Guard, was assigned to the 34th "Red Bull" Infantry Division (the 34th Div. is headquartered in Minnesota). The 32nd Brigade was now a divisional brigade and was no longer a (Separate) brigade.

On **1 October 2001** the Brigade was reorganized as the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade (Separate) (Light), Wisconsin National Guard. The 32nd Brigade is no longer attached to the 34th ID and is again a (Separate) brigade.

On **23 January 2003** about 100 soldiers from various 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade units reported for active duty for service as Task Force Red Arrow in support of Operation Noble Eagle (ONE). Task Force Red Arrow supplemented security for two years at three of Wisconsin's airbases, the 440th Air-lift Wing in Milwaukee, the 128th Air Refueling Wing in Milwaukee, and the 115th Fighter Wing in Madison.

On **20 June 2004** the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade's 1st Battalion, 128th Infantry, was mobilized in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The battalion of 680 soldiers has its Headquarters and Headquarters Company in Eau Claire; its subordinate units include Detachment 1, HHC, Abbotsford; Company A, Menomonie; Company B, New Richmond; Detachment 1, Co. B, Rice Lake; Company C, Arcadia; Detachment 1, Co. C, Neillsville; Company D, River Falls. They left Wisconsin on 23 June for training at Camp Shelby, MS,

and Fort Irwin, CA, before being deployed to Iraq.

On **6 June 2005** the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade's 2nd Battalion, 127th Infantry, was mobilized in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The battalion of 630 soldiers has its Headquarters and Headquarters Company in Appleton; its subordinate units include Company A, Waupun; Detachment 1, Co. A, Ripon; Company B, Green Bay; Company C, Fond du Lac; Company D, Marinette. They left Wisconsin on 9 June for training at Camp Shelby, MS, before being deployed overseas.

On **10 August 2005** the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade's 1st Battalion, 120th Field Artillery, was mobilized in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The Battalion has its Headquarters and Headquarters Service Battery in Wisconsin Rapids; its subordinate units include Detachment 1, HHS, Mosinee; Battery A, Marshfield; Battery B, Clintonville; Battery C, Stevens Point. They left Wisconsin on 13 August for training at Camp Shelby, MS, before being deployed overseas.

On **17 August 2005** the 32nd "Red Arrow" Infantry Brigade's 2nd Battalion, 128th Infantry, was mobilized in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The battalion of 600 soldiers has its Headquarters and Headquarters Company in Madison; its subordinate units include Company A, Fort Atkinson and Elkhorn; Company B, Oconomowoc and Hartford; Company C, Baraboo and Reedsburg; Company D, Watertown. They left Wisconsin on 20 August for training at Camp Shelby, MS, before being deployed overseas.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Under current law, state residents who are members or retired members of the national guard may obtain, for automobiles and certain other vehicles that they own or lease, special distinguishing registration plates that display the words "Wisconsin guard member" (national guard special plates).

Under this bill, if an applicant for initial issuance of national guard special plates identifies himself or herself as a member or former member of the 32nd "Red Arrow" Brigade or Division, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must affix to one of these special plates a registration decal or tag (sticker) that includes a symbol associated with the 32nd "Red Arrow" Brigade or Division. An applicant for renewal of registration of national guard special plates may also receive this registration sticker, free of charge, if the sticker was not previously affixed by DOT to either of the applicant's national guard special plates.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

Please review the attached draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent.

I suspect the official name of the national guard unit is now the <sup>✓</sup>32nd Infantry Brigade, but I'm not certain. Do you want me to use this name in the bill? Also, it might simplify the draft to refer to predecessors of the Brigade rather than referring to the Division.

It is not customary to specify the exact design of special plates or license plate stickers, so the attached draft does not do so. Is this okay?

I recommend that <sup>✓</sup>DOT review this draft. DOT may have suggestions as to the least costly means of achieving your goals.

Please let me know if you would like any changes made to the attached draft or if you have any questions. If the attached draft meets with your approval, let me know and I will convert it to an introducible <sup>✓</sup>"1" draft.

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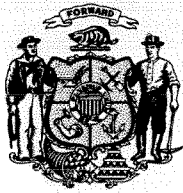

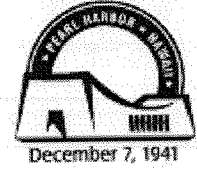
