. 2005 Representative Gunderson would like to get 2003 Assembly Bill 586 redrafted. You should incorporate Senate Amendment 1 into the draft, as well as Assembly Substitute Amendment 1. Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 made a number of changes to correct statutes that would have been inconsistent with the new law. It also changed the age from 10 (in the original bill to 8 in the Sub. Amendment). This year's draft should incorporate all of the changes from Assembly Substitute Amendment 1, with the exception of the age change from 10 to 8. The redraft for this Session should set the age at 10 years old, and give the Department of Natural Resources the rule making authority to lower the age below 10, if they can justify the lower age based upon sound science. 

- (4) A person who is authorized to hunt with a mentor under this section and a mentor under this section with whom that person hunts may jointly have only one firearm, only one bow, or, if hunting with a crossbow is authorized under s. 29.171 (4) or 29.193 (2), only one crossbow in their possession or control while hunting.
- (5) A mentor under this section may take only one person hunting at a time for whom he or she is serving as a mentor.
- (6) The department shall issue to each person to whom the department issues a hunting approval a pamphlet, developed by the department, that contains hunter safety information if the person is not required to obtain a certificate of accomplishment under s. 29.591 and is authorized to hunt with a mentor under this section.
