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

- (1) My boss wants to end the first sentence of the bill at "program" on line 5. He no longer wants to specify which agency a consolidated program would be housed in.
- (2) The report should go to the entire Assembly and Senate (however that's best worded) rather than to the committees with jurisdiction over agriculture.
- (3) The report would be due one year after the act is published.

This is more of a question than a request. Since the budget created new Department of Children and Families do we need change the DHFS title to the Department of Health (without checking, I assume that's what it's going to be called...) in the bill?
