No, there is not a list of persons who are delinquent in paying child support payments. On occasion, we get requests from counties to publish their own lists and from media doing stories on the problem, but each time the list is drawn up to meet the need.

The Child Support Lien Docket website is about the closest thing we have, it is not published anywhere and each person would have to be checked individually. The information on the website is public record and it is only available by visiting the Register of Deeds office.

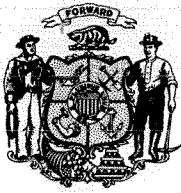

AN ACT relating to: a delinquent child support payer website.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

\* Under current law, the Department of Revenue is required to maintain an Internet website of the names of taxpayers who owe delinquent taxes in excess of \$25,000. Also under current law, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) is required to establish a program that includes publication of information, such as names and photographs, of persons who are significantly delinquent in the payment of child support. Current law also requires DWD to maintain a support lien docket that contains the names of persons who are delinquent in the payment of child support. Copies of the lien docket are provided to county registers of deeds and state agencies that title personal property.

\* This bill requires DWD to maintain a list of, and post on an Internet website, the names of persons who owe delinquent child support in excess of \$2,000. The website must contain the name, address, and amount owed for each person on the list. As with the delinquent taxpayer website, the delinquent child support payer website must have a special page for the 100 persons who owe the most. The website must be updated quarterly, and may not post the name of any person who has reached an agreement with DWD, and is in compliance with that agreement, for alternate payment arrangements or of any person who has filed for bankruptcy and is protected by a stay.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. 49.23 of the statutes is created to read:

2 **49.23 Delinquent child support obligor website.** (1) REQUIREMENT TO  
3 MAINTAIN. Except as provided in sub. (2), the department shall prepare and maintain  
4 a list of all child support obligors who are delinquent in the payment of child support,  
5 including interest, in excess of \$2,000, and shall post the names of persons from this  
6 list on the Internet at a site that is created and maintained by the department for  
7 this purpose. The Internet site shall show the name, address, and amount of  
8 delinquent child support, including interest, for each obligor on the list. The Internet  
9 site shall also contain a special page for the 100 obligors who owe the most in

This bill creates a website to report the names of delinquent child support payers, similar to the “Wall of Shame” website for delinquent tax payers, which has been incredibly successful in collecting back payments.

One of Wisconsin’s biggest terrible secrets is the amount of money that is owed in child support payments. Compared to any cost or budget of state government the amount of child support delinquent payments is astronomical!

\$2.84 billion is what is owed to children and families in back child support payments, that is a lot of Wisconsin children who are having the quality of their lives limited and their futures made less bright because certain people are not being responsible.

It’s also about state government finances as well.

\$1.01 billion is owed to the state of Wisconsin, In addition to the amount owed to the families! (This information was collected from the annual DWD report of 6/30/06.) Many times the state will make payments to a family with a low income, if they are not receiving the child support payments they are due.

It's time the legislature redoubled our efforts to collect more of this owed money. While no initiative is perfect, and not all monies will ever be collected, we can do better.

What has worked well in the past is the "Wall of Shame" website put up for delinquent tax payers. Its first year of operation, the website collected over \$16 million (It is interesting to note, the Department of Revenue in its 5/10/05 fiscal estimate anticipated only \$1.5 million would be collected the first year with diminishing returns thereafter). In actuality, an additional \$9 million has been collected so far this year.

The "Wall of Shame" website was able to collect 5.4% of the outstanding taxes due in less than two years. There is no way of knowing, but if the same successful collection percentage were applied to the website created by this bill an additional, \$208,747,000 would be collected in child support payments.

The Department of Workforce Development has been working hard to collect these child support arrears and would like to do more. An existing website might be modified to allow the public the easy access to information this bill requires.

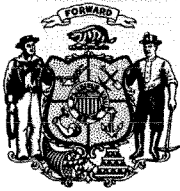

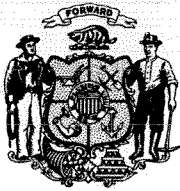

5 and whose names appear on the statewide support lien docket under s. 49.854 (2) (b),  
6 and shall post the names of persons from this list on the Internet at a site that is  
7 created and maintained by the department for this purpose. The Internet site shall  
8 show the name, county *or counties* in which the child support *order* was *issued*, and amount of  
9 delinquent child support for each obligor on the list. The Internet site shall also  
10 contain a special page for the 100 obligors who owe the most in delinquent child  
11 support. Except as provided in sub. (2) (b), the department shall *insert 2-11* update the Internet  
12 site on a *weekly* quarterly basis.

*in a total amount that exceeds \$5,000*

13 (2) EXCEPTIONS. (a) The department may not post on the Internet site under  
14 sub. (1) the name of any of the following:  
15 1. An obligor who has reached a payment agreement with the department, or  
16 a payment agreement that has been approved by a county child support agency  
17 under s. 59.53 (5) and that is consistent with rules promulgated under s. 49.858 (2)  
18 (a), and who is in compliance with that agreement.
