## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

AB 754 would require the Director of State Courts to remove from the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (WCCA) Internet website records from cases involving a civil forfeiture, misdemeanor or felony in which one of the following applies:

(a) cases or charges have been dismissed;

(b) a person was found not guilty of all of the charges; or

(c) a case or charge has been overturned on appeal and dismissed.

This bill will require re-programming by the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) staff to restrict access to the specified records. It is estimated that making the changes for the dismissed CT, CF and CM cases (Criminal Traffic, Criminal Felony and Criminal Misdemeanor) to no longer appear would be approximately 320 hours of a contract programmer's time, at a cost of about \$20,000.
