

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,
TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 770**

February 28, 2008 – Offered by Representative KESTELL.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “(c) No person engaged in any of the following activities may claim the
4 exemption under par. (b):

5 1. Research that destroys a human embryo or uses cells or tissue derived from
6 the destruction of a human embryo that was destroyed after August 9, 2001.

7 2. Creating human embryos for research purposes.

8 3. Cloning human embryos for any purpose.”.

9 **2.** Page 3, line 7: after that line insert:

10 “(c) No person engaged in any of the following activities may claim the
11 exemption under par. (b):

12 1. Research that destroys a human embryo or uses cells or tissue derived from
13 the destruction of a human embryo that was destroyed after August 9, 2001.

1 2. Creating human embryos for research purposes.

2 3. Cloning human embryos for any purpose.”.

3 **3.** Page 5, line 1: after “*Limitations.*” insert “1.”.

4 **4.** Page 5, line 2: after that line insert:

5 “2. No corporation may claim a credit under this subsection if the corporation

6 is engaged in any of the following activities:

7 a. Research that destroys a human embryo or uses cells or tissue derived from
8 the destruction of a human embryo that was destroyed after August 9, 2001.

9 b. Creating human embryos for research purposes.

10 c. Cloning human embryos for any purpose.”.

11 **5.** Page 6, line 15: after “*Limitations.*” insert “1.”.

12 **6.** Page 6, line 16: after that line insert:

13 “2. No corporation may claim a credit under this subsection if the corporation

14 is engaged in any of the following activities:

15 a. Research that destroys a human embryo or uses cells or tissue derived from
16 the destruction of a human embryo that was destroyed after August 9, 2001.

17 b. Creating human embryos for research purposes.

18 c. Cloning human embryos for any purpose.”.

19 **7.** Page 8, line 2: after that line insert:

20 “(c) No person engaged in any of the following activities may claim the
21 exemption under par. (b):

22 1. Research that destroys a human embryo or uses cells or tissue derived from
23 the destruction of a human embryo that was destroyed after August 9, 2001.

24 2. Creating human embryos for research purposes.
