

October 11, 2005 – Introduced by Representatives Parisi, Black, Mosser, Pocan, Turner, Bergeau Grigsby, Seidel, Fields, Sheridan and Molepske, cosponsored by Senators Erpenbach and Risser. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

AN ACT *to amend* 20.235 (1) (b), 20.235 (1) (fe), 20.235 (1) (ff), 20.235 (1) (km), 20.285 (4) (dd), 20.505 (8) (hm) 10., 36.34 (1) (c) 1. a., 36.34 (1) (c) 1. b., 36.34 (1) (c) 2. (intro.), 36.34 (1) (c) 2. b., 39.435 (7) (a) 1., 39.435 (7) (a) 2., 39.435 (7) (b) (intro.) and 39.435 (7) (b) 2.; and *to create* 36.34 (1) (c) 2. am., 39.30 (5), 39.435 (7) (a) 3., 39.435 (7) (a) 4., 39.435 (7) (a) 5., 39.435 (7) (a) 6., 39.435 (7) (b) 1m., 39.435 (7) (c) and 39.435 (7) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** the method by which the amounts to be appropriated for higher education grants, tuition grants, and Lawton minority undergraduate grants are calculated and making appropriations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Higher Educational Aids Board (HEAB) provides higher education grants to Wisconsin residents who are enrolled in the University of Wisconsin (UW) System, a technical college, or a tribal college and tuition grants to Wisconsin residents who are enrolled in accredited, nonprofit post–high school, educational institutions in this state. The Board Regents of the UW System provides grants, known as Lawton grants, to minority undergraduates enrolled in the UW System.

ASSEMBLY BILL 743 with the 2007-09 state fiscal blemmum

Currently, sum certain amounts are appropriated in each fiscal year for tuition grants and for higher education grants for technical college and tribal college students. For higher education grants for UW System students, beginning in fiscal year 2005 06, there is appropriated a sum sufficient equal to the amount appropriated for those grants in the previous fiscal year (base amount) increased by the highest percentage increase in undergraduate academic fees among the institutions within the UW System between the current and previous academic years, except that, if the undergraduate academic fees at each institution within the UW System for the current academic year did not increase from the previous academic year, the appropriation for the current fiscal year remains the base amount. The same formula is also used to calculate the amount appropriated for (with the 2009-11 state Fiscal pleanium) Lawton grants. (average)

This bill changes the formula used to calculate the amounts appropriated for higher education grants for UW System students and for Lawton grants. The bill also requires HEAB to use the new formula to calculate the amounts appropriated for tuition grants and for higher education grants for technical college and tribal college students. Specifically, under the bill, beginning in fiscal year 2006-07, the amounts appropriated for tuition grants, for Lawton grants, and for higher education grants for UW System students, technical college students, and tribal college students are determined by increasing the base amount for each of those appropriations by the greater of the highest percentage increase determined under current law or the amount obtained by multiplying the increase in the undergraduate academic fees charged for a student to attend the UW-Madison for the current academic year over the previous academic year by the number of students who recipe he respective grants for the previous academic year except that, if the undergraduate academic fees at each institution within the UW System did not increase from the previous academic year, the appropriations for the current fiscal year remain the base amounts

2005 Wisconsin Act 25 changed the formula for calculating the amounts to be appropriated for WHEG grants and Lawton grants beginning with the 2007-09 biennium by:

- 1. Requiring increases in those amounts to be based on the *average* percentage increase in academic fees among institutions within the UW System rather than on the *highest* percentage increase in academic fees among those institutions.
 - 2. Requiring those calculations to be made biennially rather than annually beginning on February 1, 2007.

Accordingly this draft differs from 2005 AB 743 as follows:

1. Under the draft, the amounts to be appropriated are based on the average percentage increase in academic fees among institutions within the UW System or the dollar increase in academic fees at the UW Madison, whichever is greater.

2. Because by the time the draft is enacted, the February 1, 2007, deadline for HEAB to make the calculations for the 2007-09 biennium will already have come and gone, the draft first applies to the 2009-11 biennium.
