2	Whereas, each year during the month of March we recognize the humanitarian
3	service and the lifesaving programs of the American Red Cross; and
4	Whereas, part of the international Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, the
5	American Red Cross was formed 125 years ago and chartered by Congress to provide
6	aid and comfort in times of crisis; and
7	Whereas, since the early years of twentieth century, the Red Cross in Wisconsin
8	has played a critical role in helping our citizens prevent, prepare for, and respond to
9	emergencies; and
10	Whereas, American Red Cross volunteers and staff responded to 878 local
11	disasters throughout the state of Wisconsin last year, providing emergency
12	assistance to 1,300 families affected by fire, flood, tornadoes, and other disasters. In
13	2006, 85,932 persons learned to prevent and prepare for disasters by participating
14	in Red Cross community disaster education programs: and
