

Rep. Honadel would like to request a draft of an Assembly Joint Resolution that declares May as Manufacturing Month in Wisconsin and states:

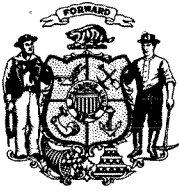

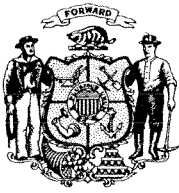
