10 participation of over 6,500 individual citizens of the state and legislators, and introduced over
11 1,300 pieces of legislation on a wide variety of topics, leading to more than 750 enactments;

13 Whereas, the Joint Legislative Council study process has produced legislation in
14 specific areas such as protection of groundwater, criminal code and penalties, insurance laws
15 revisions, court reorganization, education, marital property, mediation-arbitration

2 services; and

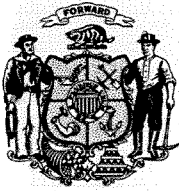
3 Whereas, through its many functions, both large and small, and in concert with its sister
