TO 2007 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION (LRB-0987/4)

1 At the locations indicated, amend the resolution as follows:

2 1. Page 3, line 14: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 5m. Assembly rule 56 (1) is amended to read:

4 ASSEMBLY RULE 56 (1) Any member who desires to speak in debate or submit any
5 matter to the assembly shall rise in his or her assigned place and respectfully address
6 the presiding officer. Upon being recognized, the member shall confine his or her
7 remarks to the question before the assembly and shall avoid personalities. A
8 member may be recognized or addressed only by the number of the member's district
9 or, by the county or municipality in which the member resides, or by the member's
10 last name preceded by the "The Honorable Representative." The presiding officer
11 may specify which form of recognition or address is appropriate at any time."
