Hi Becky –

Senator Kedzie would like to have two amendments drafted for Senate Bill 15. The bill may be taken up on Tuesday, October 30th, so there is a bit of a rush.

- Senate Amendment 2 to the bill, would replace “at the pleasure of the board” under 15.05(1)(b) with “a term of four years”
- Senate Amendment 3 to the bill, would amend 15.05 (1)(b) to add “and the advice and consent of the Senate” following “with the approval of the board”

The intent is to create a four-year term for the appointed Secretary and maintain the advice and consent of the Senate for such an appointment.

SENATE AMENDMENT,
TO 2007 SENATE BILL 15

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 1, line 1: after "appointment" insert "and term of service". ✓

3 2. Page 1, line 4: delete "The secretary" and substitute "The Before January
4 3, 2011, the secretary". ✓

5 3. Page 1, line 6: delete that line and substitute "pleasure of the governor.
6 After January 2, 2011, the secretary of natural resources shall be nominated by the
7 natural resources board, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed,
8 for a 4-year term ending on July 1.". ✓

9 4. Page 1, line 6: after that line insert:

10 "SECTION 17.20 (2) (b) of the statutes is ~~amended~~ to read:

11 17.20 (2) (b) A vacancy occurring in the ~~membership of the professional~~ ^{office of secretary of natural resources}
12 ~~standards council for teachers~~ may be filled by a provisional appointment by the ~~state superintendent of public instruction~~ ^{natural resources board} after January 25, 2015
13 ~~state superintendent of public instruction~~ for the residue of the unexpired term, if

1 any, subject to confirmation by the senate. Any ~~such~~ ^{provisional} appointment shall be in full
2 force until acted upon by the senate, and when confirmed by the senate shall
3 continue for the residue of the unexpired term, if any, or until a successor is chosen
4 and qualifies. A provisional appointee may exercise all of the powers and duties of
5 the office to which the person is appointed during the time in which the appointee
6 qualifies. Any appointment made under this paragraph that is withdrawn or
7 rejected by the senate shall lapse. When a provisional appointment lapses, a vacancy
8 occurs. Whenever a new legislature is organized, any appointments then pending
9 before the senate shall be referred by the president to the appropriate standing
10 committee of the newly organized senate." ✓ ✓
