### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, dentists licensed by the Dentistry Examining Board (board) must apply to the board to renew their licenses every two years. This bill prohibits the board from renewing a dentist's license unless the dentist has taught, prepared, attended, or otherwise completed 30 credit hours of continuing education related to the practice of dentistry, including not less than 25 credit hours of instruction in clinical dentistry or clinical medicine. Under the bill, credit hours completed before the two–year period immediately preceding renewal may not be applied to satisfy the credit hours required for renewal. The bill authorizes the board to grant an extension to a dentist who is physically disabled and requires a dentist to keep a written record of continuing education he or she completes. Under the bill, the board may not require a dentist to prove compliance with the continuing education requirement unless the dentist is the subject of a complaint.
