

2007 SENATE BILL 79

March 1, 2007 – Introduced by Senator LASSA, cosponsored by Representatives VRUWINK, ALBERS and GRONEMUS. Referred to Committee on Small Business, Emergency Preparedness, Workforce Development, Technical Colleges and Consumer Protection.

1 **AN ACT to create** 100.55 of the statutes; **relating to:** the sale and distribution
2 of elastic yo-yos and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the sale or distribution of an elastic yo-yo, defined in the bill as any toy known as a “yo-yo waterball” or any other similar toy consisting of a rubber-like object that is attached to an elastic cord.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report concerning the proposed penalty and the costs or savings that are likely to result if the bill is enacted.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 100.55 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **100.55 Sale and distribution of elastic yo-yos prohibited. (1)** In this
5 section, “elastic yo-yo” means any toy known as a “yo-yo waterball” or any similar
6 toy consisting of a rubber-like object that is attached to an elastic cord.

7 **(2)** No person may sell or distribute an elastic yo-yo to a person in this state.
