

**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2007 SENATE BILL 148**

June 8, 2007 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM, RURAL ISSUES
AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 1.** 70.05 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 70.05 (5) (b) Each taxation district shall assess property at full value at least
5 once in every 5–year period. Before a city, village, or town assessor may revalue
6 property under this paragraph, the city, village, or town shall publish a notice on its
7 municipal Web site that a revaluation will occur and the approximate dates of the
8 property revaluation. The notice shall also describe the authority of an assessor,
9 under ss. 943.13 and 943.15, to enter land. If a municipality does not have a Web site,
10 it shall post the required information in at least 3 public places within the city,
11 village, or town.”.

12 **2.** Page 2, line 1: delete “**SECTION 1**” and substitute “**SECTION 1m**”.
