

**SENATE AMENDMENT 4,
TO 2007 SENATE BILL 150**

January 11, 2008 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, SENIOR ISSUES, LONG
TERM CARE AND PRIVACY.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 10, line 10: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 50g.** 101.123 (3) (ks) of the statutes is created to read:

4 101.123 (3) (ks) A retail establishment that sells cigars, as provided under sub.
5 (3r).”.

6 **2.** Page 10, line 14: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 51m.** 101.123 (3r) of the statutes is created to read:

8 101.123 (3r) CIGAR RETAILERS. The owner of a retail establishment selling
9 cigars may allow customers to sample cigars in order for the customers to determine
10 whether to make a purchase if all of the following apply:

11 (a) The retail establishment derives not less than 50 percent of its annual gross
12 income from the on-site sale of tobacco, tobacco products, or tobacco product
13 accessories.
